It has been a busy 3 weeks in Room 1 learning all about being Firewise. We know to "Get down, get low and get out FAST!" if there is ever a house fire.



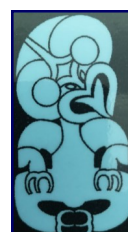
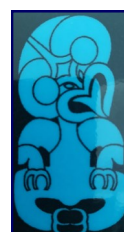
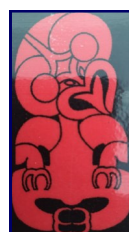
