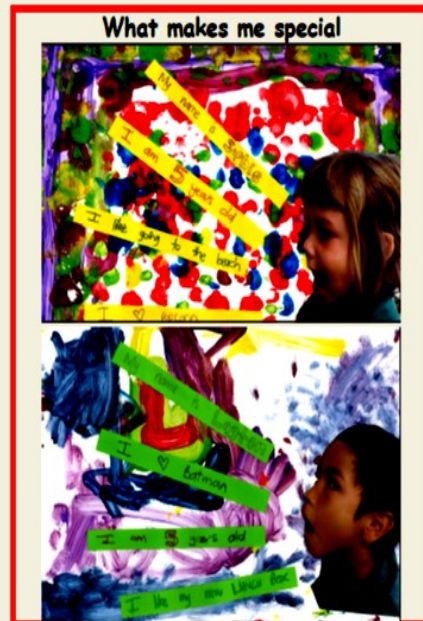


**JUNIOR SYNDICATE NEWS FROM ROOM 5:****ROOM 5**

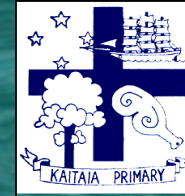

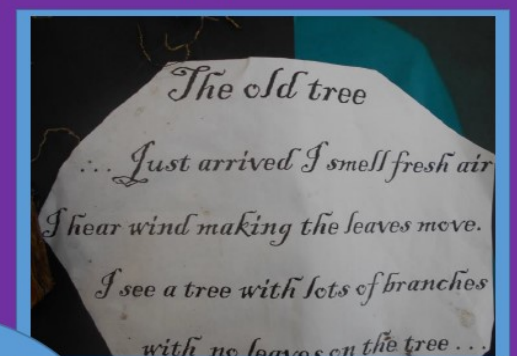
Easter is fast approaching (March 30th - April 3rd) and I hope everyone has managed to get some tickets in our Easter raffle being run this year by our Junior School.

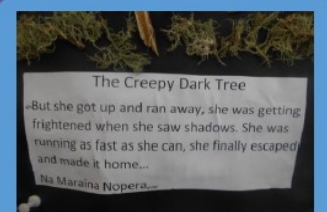

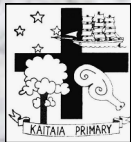
**SENIOR SYNDICATE NEWS FROM ROOM 20:****Ruma Rua Tekau (R20)**
