FROM ROOM 10:

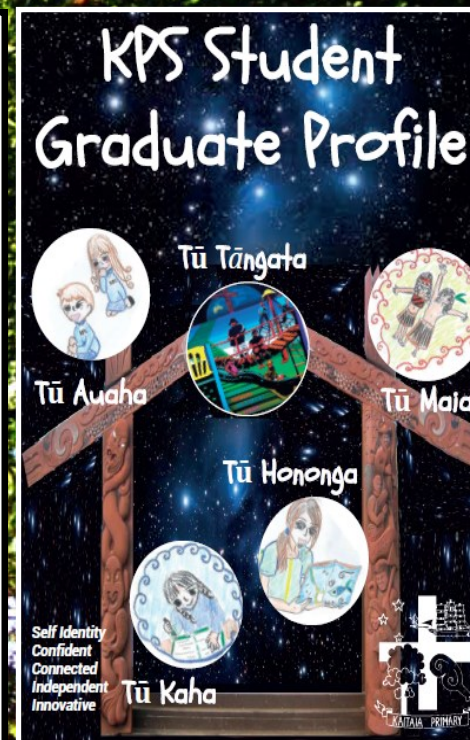


Kia ora whanau!

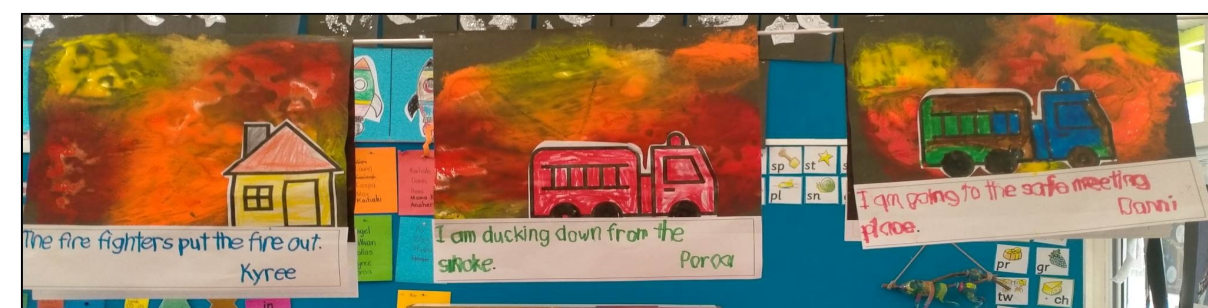
JUNIOR SCHOOL NEWS FROM ROOM 2:
