

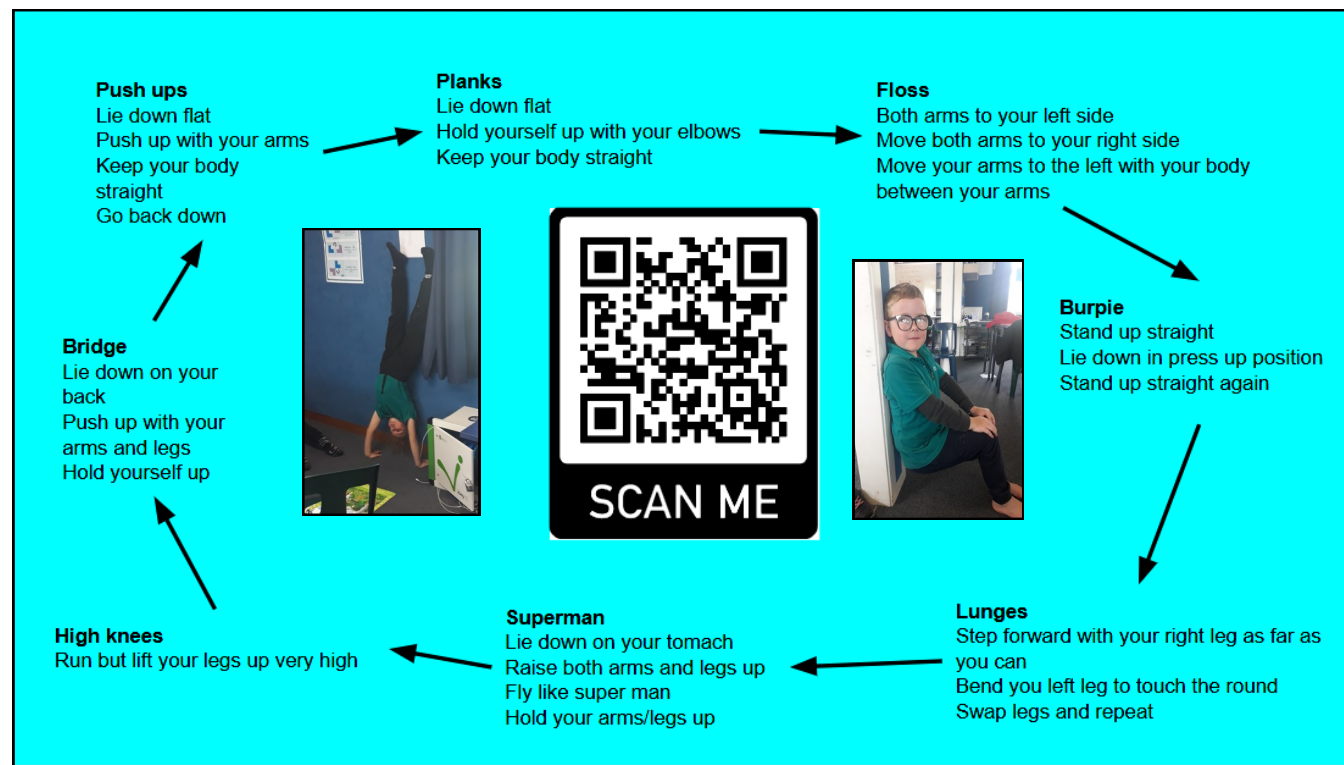


SENIOR SYNDICATE NEWS FROM ROOM 14:

We would like to invite you to try out one of our student designed programs with us.



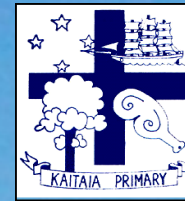

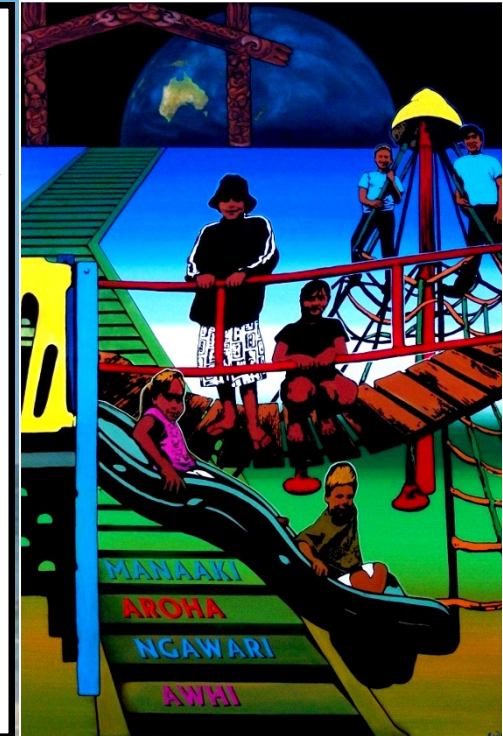

TENNIS COACHING IN TERM 4

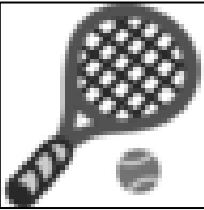
Tennis coaching is being offered in Term 1 and Term 4 to children aged 6 years to 18 years.
