It was such an awesome adventure filled with many first time experiences that we hope will be remembered fondly in years to come.



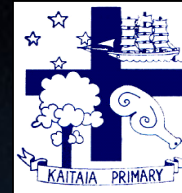

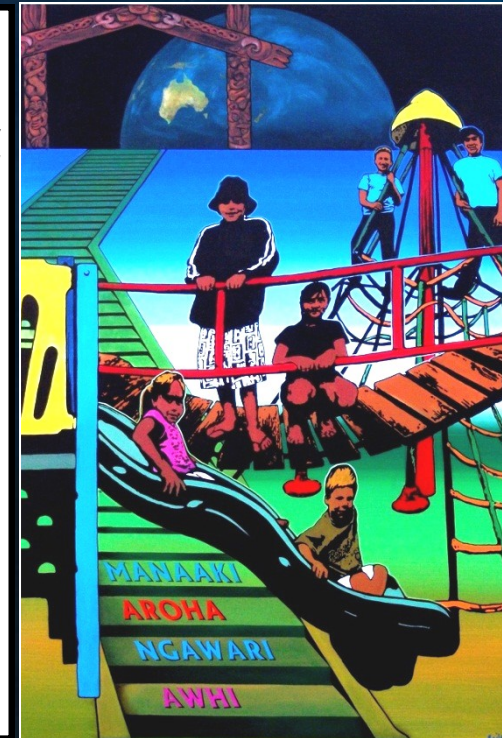

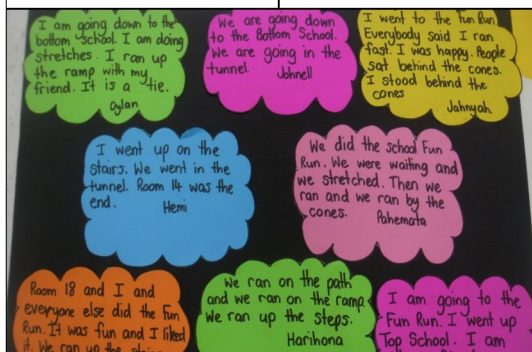
**Room 18 Junior

We celebrated "Te Wiki o te Reo Maori" by going on a Hikoi with Rooms 11 & 19 and other Kura from our Wahi.



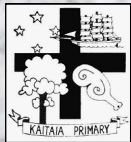
We also created new ice-cream flavours for Tip Top.
