



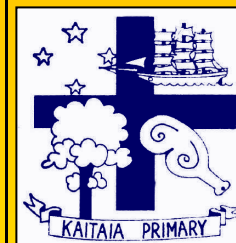
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## JUNIOR SCHOOL NEWS FROM ROOM 8:

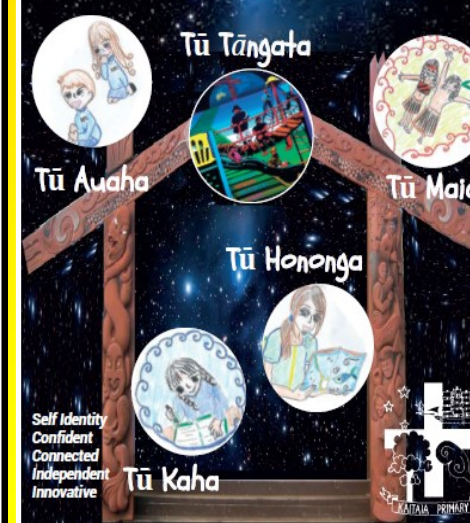
## Kia ora whanau!

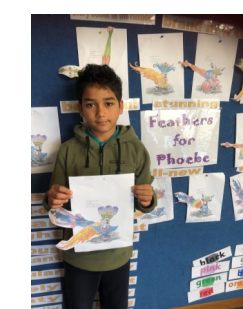

Kia ora koutou.

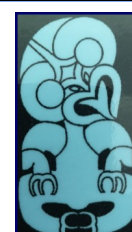
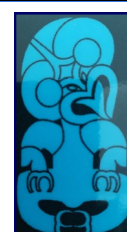
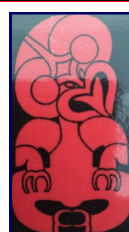
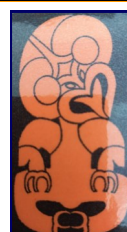
