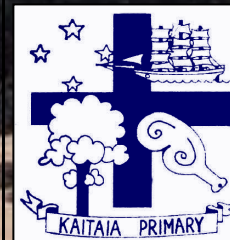

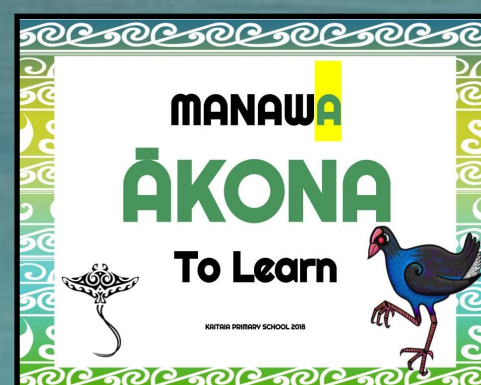


JUNIOR SYNDICATE NEWS FROM ROOM 4:

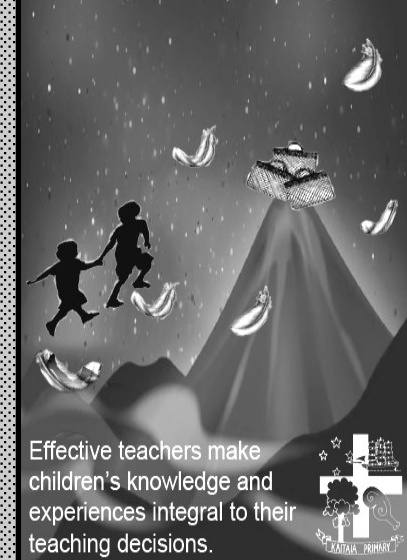

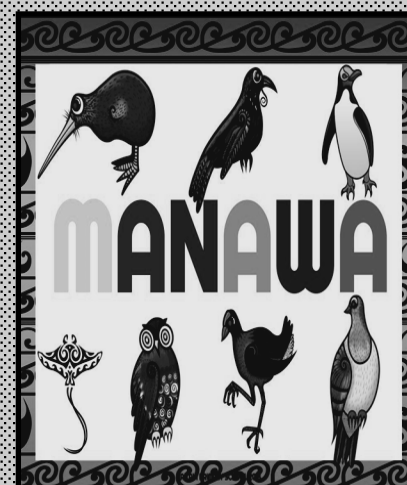
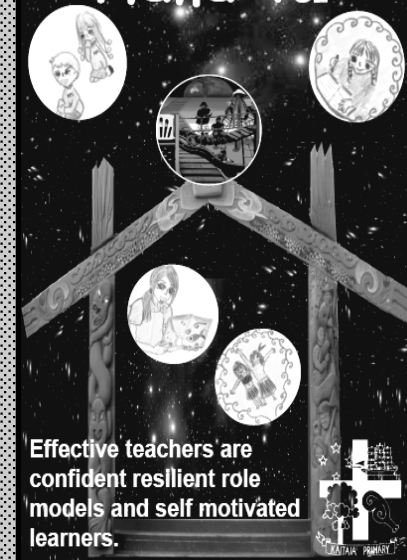
Cut visible fat from meat, and skin from chicken when preparing dishes such as boil up and hangi to reduce the fat!
