Peaceful and happy, engaged

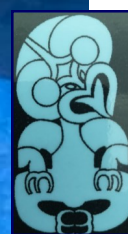
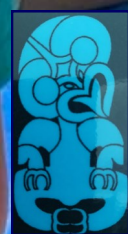
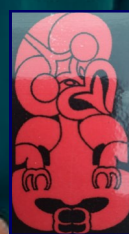
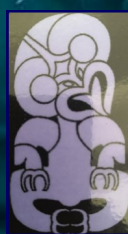
**Māui-tikitiki**

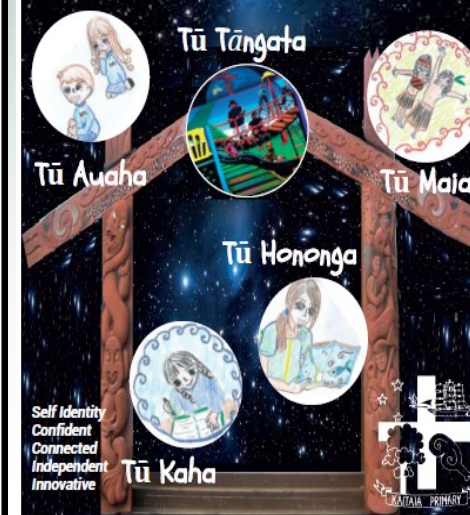
### Kia ora whanau!
