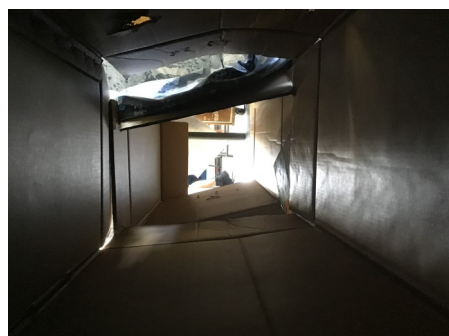


**SENIOR SYNDICATE NEWS FROM ROOM 11:**

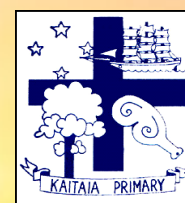

2) Then we put some fruit salad and juice over the sponge.....



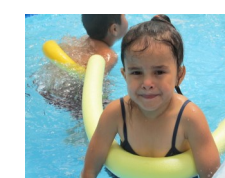
3) Then we spooned some Custard over the fruit....



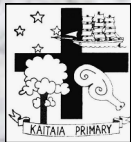
4) We squirted some cream on and added Some sprinkles.....
