Each week the students were challenged to solve a problem in a fairy tale.

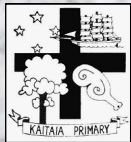
So far they have made a raft for the billy goats gruff to get across the river, made a new chair for baby bear, and made a stronger house for the 3 little pigs.

KUMARA SALAD

SUPER SUMMER SALADS

- 3 kumara – cut into cubes
- 2 Tbsp. oil
- 1 capsicum - chopped
- ½ red onion – chopped
- large handful of salad greens e.g. spinach
- optional: 70g Feta – cut into cubes
- 2 tsp. honey
- juice of 1 lemon

Place kumara in a roasting dish, drizzle with oil and bake at 180° for 20 minutes. Remove from oven to cool then toss with the vegetables. In a bowl whisk together honey and lemon juice then drizzle over the salad.

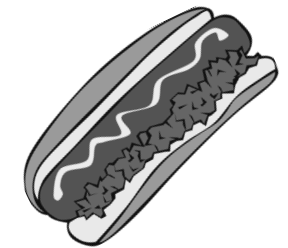
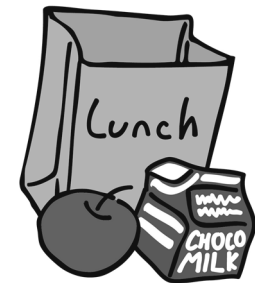
SCHOOL LUNCH ORDERS 2017
