Room 5

A highlight for this term was our Junior School trip to Waitangi. Some things we learnt about were the history of Te Tiriti o Waitangi and the arrival of Kupe. We had lots of fun flying kites.

For our inquiry topic Room 5 have been learning about simple machines: wheel and axle, lever, inclined plane, wedge, screw and pulley. We learnt that they make doing work easier by helping us lift, lower, move, split, push and pull objects. We had fun making our pulleys and using them to lift items in the classroom.



Room 6

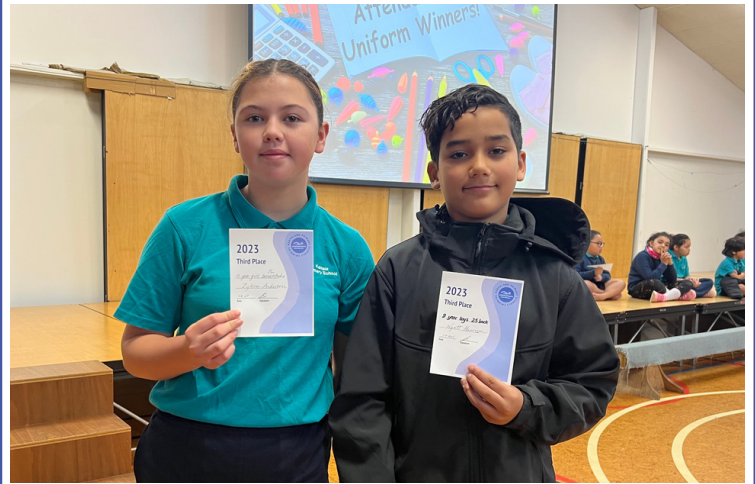
