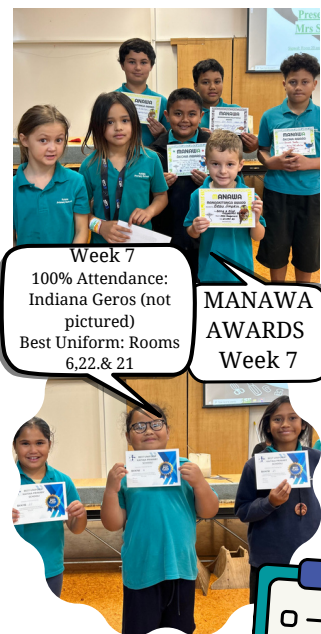

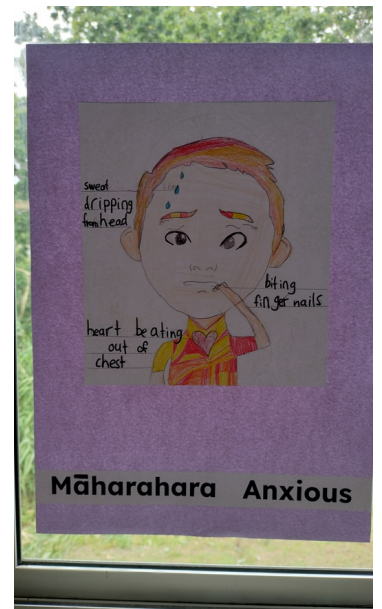
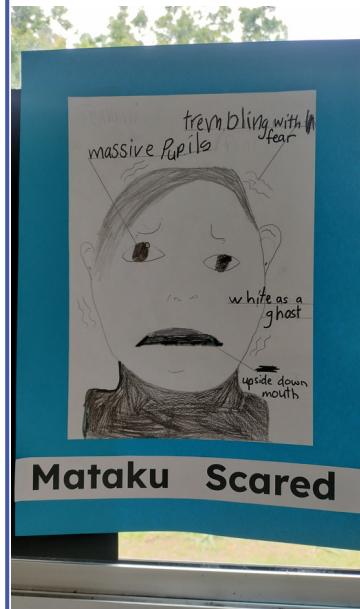
## Room 11
